The issues discussed were:

**Men's Championship**

Last year, the Men's Championship was moved from the blue to the white tees to increase participation in the championship flight. It was felt that this diminished the club championship since the same tees were used for the club championship and the senior championship. It was decided that the men's club championship will be played from the combined blue/white tees this year.

**2024 WMGA Board**

It was proposed that we retain the current board through 2024 to manage the transition to new ownership that hopefully will be completed by then. The proposal will be made to the members at the annual membership meeting for a vote. We always have room for new board members who are interested in helping manage the WMGA tournaments and related activities

**Member Guest Tournament**

We had 48 golfers who played in the Member-Guest this year. Using a combination of the Grill and an outside vendor for meals and \$1,225 from sponsorship funds, we managed to break even.

**Membership/Finance**

All bills due through the current time have been paid and we have a balance on hand of \$9,253.93. We have 100 WMGA members, down from 105 in 2022. We lost 20 members, but gained 15 new members

TMG membership currently stands at 53 paid members. There is a total of \$5,220.54 in the treasury for awards and luncheons. The TMG will be holding its summer picnic on Tuesday July 18<sup>th</sup> at Wintercamp Park.

## **Proshop News**

The Proshop is asking WMGA members to set an example for all golfers by following course management guidelines. When permitted to drive onto the fairways, use the 90° rule. This means that you drive to your approximate ball location on the cart path, then drive to your ball. You should then return directly to the cart path. Driving up the fairway or through the rough to your next ball location is not 90°. Similarly, please exit the fairway before, not after, the cart path signs. It is especially critical that you keep all four wheels on the cart path around the tee and green areas. Staying off the bare spots in these areas will allow the dirt to decompress so that they can be reseeded.
